

# Join our team! Intern: Technical and Backstage Assistant

This is a great opportunity to join the Springs team on their most well-known and loved Advent tour of churches as a volunteer, learning and/or applying technical and stage management skills.

NO EXPERIENCE REQUIRED. This is a chance to learn new skills on the job.

# Job description

#### **KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:**

To assist in the smooth running, setting up and operation of productions on tour.

#### **PERSONAL SPECIFICATION:**

The successful applicant will be a component person (18 or over) willing to help in any way possible to ensure the smooth running of the tour.

You will also need to have:

- Willingness and ability to learn and adapt to any unfamiliar task and situation
- Willingness to share communal travel and accommodation.
- Willingness and ability to join a Covid-safe bubble should the need arise for the duration of the tour.

### The roles and responsibilities of the Technical / Backstage Assistant will include:

- a) To assist in the loading and unloading of all equipment, props, dance floor and accessories for all Springs venues.
- b) To assist in the set up for each show as directed by the Rehearsal Director and Technician. This includes but is not limited to:-
- Setting and dressing props for the show
- Ironing costumes
- Preparing suitable backstage areas
- Supporting the company in preparing the performance and audience space
- Packing away after the performance
- Maintaining or purchasing props and costumes between performances
- c) To provide technical support for Springs performances as directed by the Technician. This includes but is not limited to:-
- Rigging, cabling, focusing and de-rigging suitable lighting equipment
- Rigging, cabling, equalising and de-rigging suitable sound equipment
- d) To ensure that equipment is used correctly and that at all times the company is working in a safe environment in line with the show risk assessment.

# Depending on experience, there may also be the opportunity to:

- a) Join the dancers in their daily warm-up / class and rehearsals
- b) Operate sound and/or lights as required during class, rehearsals and performances working from a previously prepared script or cue sheet.
- c) Drive the company and equipment in the van to and from performance venues.

# This is a voluntary role.

Accommodation and some meals are provided when touring.
